E. Moeller welcomed the group and began introductions.

J. Braun gave the Secretary's Report. The revised flyer for the Nov 6 Youth Survey Presentation was passed out. J. Braun to email the new version to all school newsletters.

E. Moeller gave the Treasurer's Report. We have \$1668.57 in the savings account and \$2011 in the checking account, for a total of \$3679.57. E. Moeller noted that we have received donations from parents as part of our Party Guideline Responses (approximately 35 returned Guidelines).

E. Moeller showed a video presentation on social norming and the perception vs. reality issue of alcohol use in a high school.

B. Lyon gave the PHY Report, making note of upcoming Parent Network Meetings (10/17 & 11/21; 7-9pm) at Great Valley Middle School. All T/E residents are invited. Topics at the meeting are chosen by the parents in attendance.

A. Meisinger reported on the Peer Mediation/Links Program which has upperclassmen working in freshman homerooms on a variety of topics including conflict resolution, listening, & respecting others.

E. Moeller gave an update on the ARCH/CHS Athletic Department partnership. ARCH provided Public Service Announcements for the Homecoming Game, plus signage at the game and an ad in the Football program.

E. Moeller shared information about the Caring Communities Coalition, a countywide youth services organization which meets quarterly. Their next meeting is December 8<sup>th</sup>.

Nancy Clegg from COAD passed out brochures outlining a "menu" of services, materials, videos and program which COAD will provide. She is looking for feedback and input regarding the brochure and all the material that is available to schools and organizations.

B. Lyon gave the Youth Committee update. Their next meeting is October 10 at 7:30pm. The Youth Committee is working on Youth Focus Groups which are comprised of 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders (10 per grade) to discuss alcohol and drug use and student perceptions. These will be offsite and conducted by a moderator. They are tentatively scheduled for Dec 1<sup>st</sup>.

The Youth Survey Presentation Committee has been meeting to discuss the details of the Presentation which will take place on Nov 6 at the Upper Main Line YMCA. E. Moeller requested names and addresses of community leaders and organizations which should receive invitations.

E. Moeller discussed the ARCH Listserv site. We are trying to figure out if we can each log on independently (w/ own passwords) or if we all have to log on under one name.

The meeting was adjourned.
